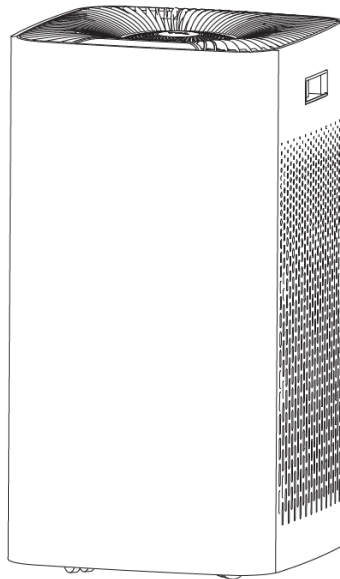

Please read the manual carefully before using the product

READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE USAGE

1. Before use, ensure the rated voltage indicated on the appliance match the supply voltage.
2. If the supply cord shows visible signs of damage, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent, or similarly qualified persons to avoid hazard. Regularly check the condition of the power cord for any damage.
3. Do not allow the power cable to be pulled or crushed by a heavy load.
4. Never connect the air purifier with the power cord or plug that is damaged to the mains. Use only a grounded outlet.
5. Do not connect any other appliances on the same line. It may result in over-heating and fire.
6. Never immerse the power cable, plug and appliance in water, or rinse it under the tap to avoid the risk of electrocution.
7. Never disassemble your air purifier or replace any components to avoid any hazards.
8. To avoid the risk of fire, do not operate the unit in the presence of explosive fumes and/or flammable.
9. Do not dismantle or modify the air purifier without prior authorization.
10. Unauthorized servicing may result in electric shock, malfunction, or fire.
11. Do not use solvents or chemical cleaners such as benzene, thinner, or similar substances to clean the product.
12. Keep the unit away from aerosols or spray products.
13. Do not install or operate the air purifier in kitchens or areas containing greasy particles, as grease accumulation will significantly reduce the service life and effectiveness of the filter.
14. Ensure unit is always placed on a leveled surface
15. This air purifier is not designed to remove carbon monoxide (CO). It should not be used as a safety device for toxic gas detection or removal.
16. Do not use the air purifier in rooms where fumigation-type pesticides are applied, as chemical residues may damage the unit and pose health risks.
17. Do not place or operate the air purifier in high-temperature or high-humidity environments, such as bathrooms. Exposure to moisture may cause electrical leakage, leading to electric shock or fire.
18. Always ensure the unit and its exterior are completely dry before operation.
19. Operating the appliance while wet may result in short circuits, electric shock, or fire.
20. Keep the product away from volatile or flammable substances to reduce the risk of fire or explosion.
21. Immediately switch off the power and disconnect the unit if any abnormalities are observed, such as unusual noise, odor, smoke, or malfunction.
22. In case of dropping, visible deterioration, or leakage, the product should not be used. Do not drag the product on the floor.
23. Do not inject perfume, vinegar, descaling agents, or other chemicals onto the product. This product is not suitable for use with these chemicals.
24. This product is intended for household indoor usage. Not for usage in bathrooms or outdoors.
25. This appliance can be used by children aged 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning the use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved.
26. Do not allow children to play with the product.

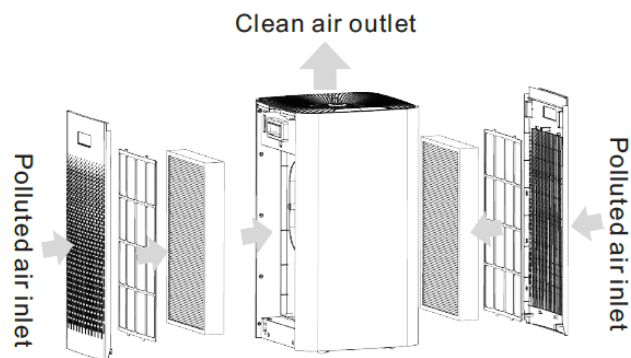
STORAGE

1. Ensure to turn the power OFF on the air purifier
2. Unplug the power plug from the power outlet when usage is completed
3. Place the unit in an upright position and store in a cool and dry place.

MAINTENANCE

1. Ensure the unit is turned off and unplugged from the power supply before cleaning or maintenance.
2. Do not use harsh or abrasive cleaners, chemicals, or solvents.
3. Never immerse the air purifier in water or other liquids.
4. Do not drop, throw, or attempt to bend the unit.
5. Do not attempt to disassemble the appliance.
6. Keep the air purifier away from heat sources and direct sunlight.
7. Always ensure the air purifier's inlet and outlet are free from dust. Clean using only a dry cloth or brush.
8. It is recommended to replace the filter every 6 months of use.

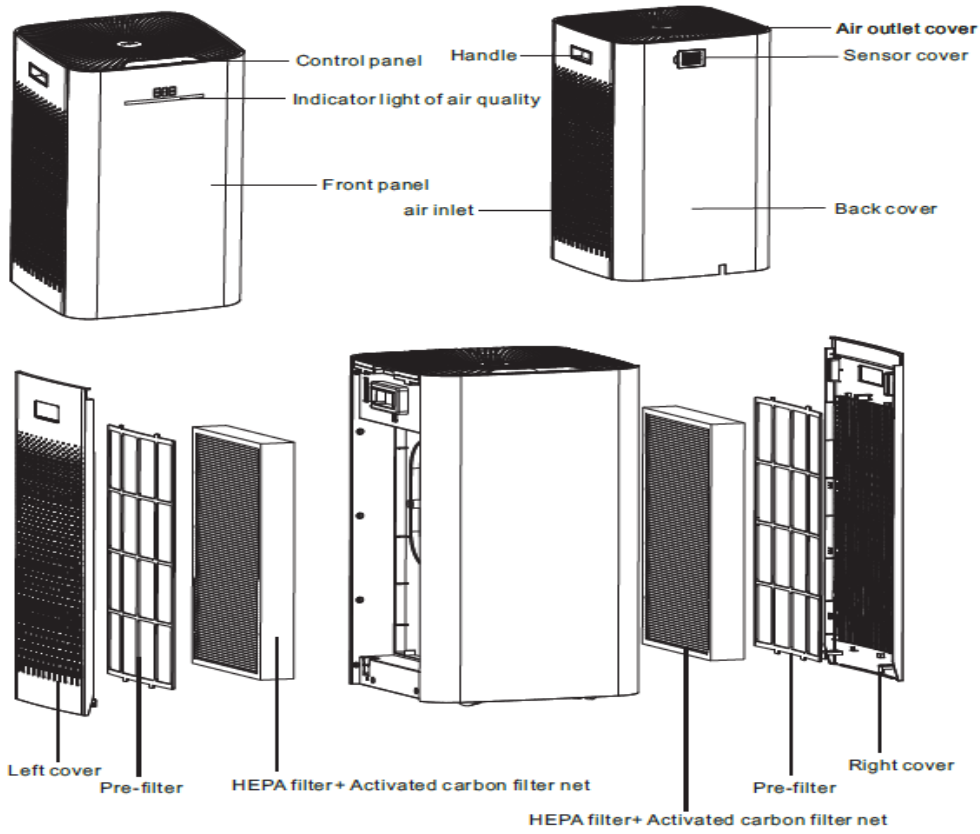

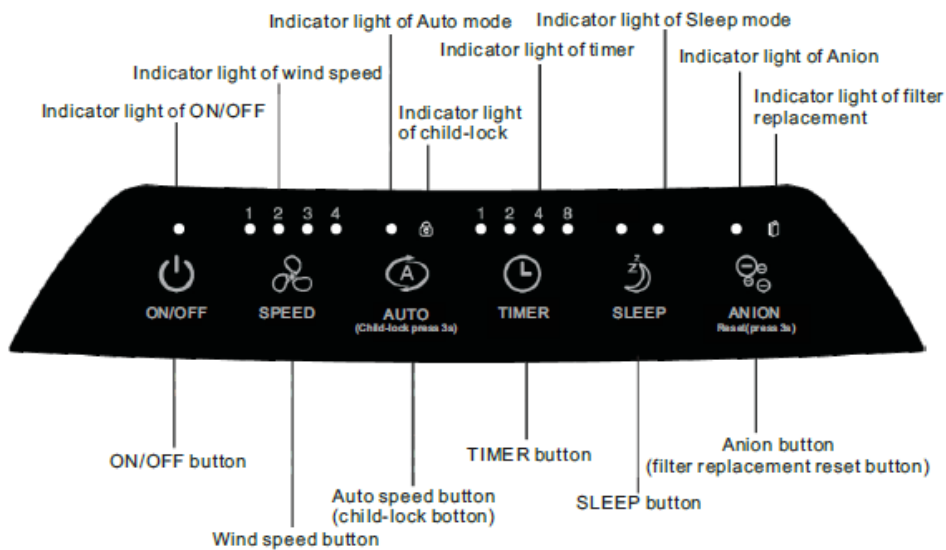
4 STEPS PURIFICATION TECHNOLOGY

1. **Pre-filter:** Captures hair, fibers, large particles, and dander.
2. **HEPA filter:** Effectively removes PM2.5, smoke, pollen, mites, and other fine particles.
3. **High-quality modified activated carbon filter:** Made from premium activated carbon and enhanced with proprietary technology to efficiently remove formaldehyde and other gaseous pollutants.
4. **Negative ions:** Releases abundant negative oxygen ions; often called "vitamins in the air", to make the air fresh and natural.

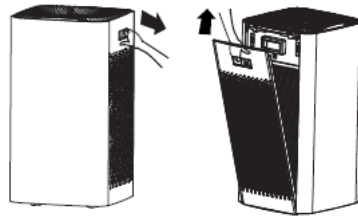

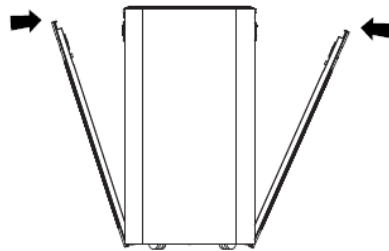


ASSEMBLY & DISASSEMBLY OF SIDE COVERS

Disassembly: Grasp the handles on both sides of the side covers, pull them outward, and carefully lift the covers to unlatch them from the unit.

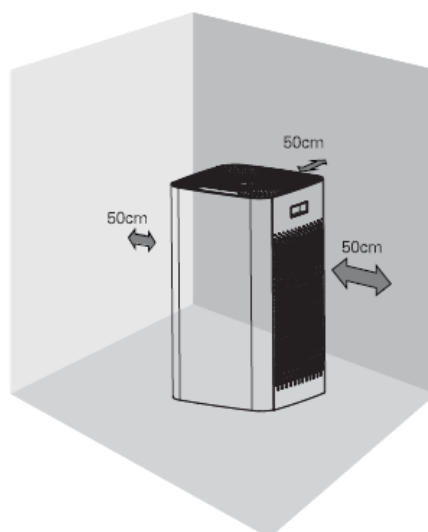


Assembly: Align the hooks at the bottom of the cover with the unit and latch them in place. Then, push the cover back onto the side of the unit. Repeat for the other side cover.



PLACEMENT OF AIR PURIFIER

- Keep at least 50 cm between the air purifier's inlet and walls, curtains, or other objects. Maintain 1 meter from TVs, radios, or other electrical appliances.
- Do not share the same power socket with TVs or radios, as this may cause interference or noise.
- Do not block the air inlet or outlet; ensure sufficient ventilation around the unit.



INSTALLATION OF FILTER BEFORE USING

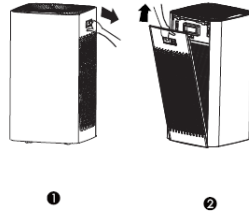
All filters come installed with the unit. Remove all filter packaging before use. Follow the steps below to disassemble the filters. Ensure the unit is unplugged before proceeding.

Step 1

Remove all packaging from the exterior of the unit. Place the unit on a leveled smooth surface.

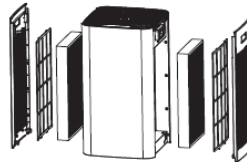
Step 2

Open the side covers by pulling outward and lifting them off the bottom latches.



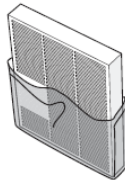
Step 3

Remove all internal filters from the unit.



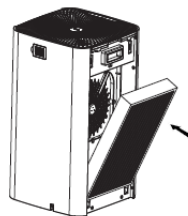
Step 4

Take off all packaging from the filters.



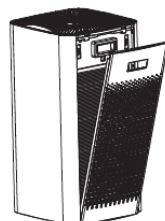
Step 5

Insert the filters back into the air purifier.



Step 6

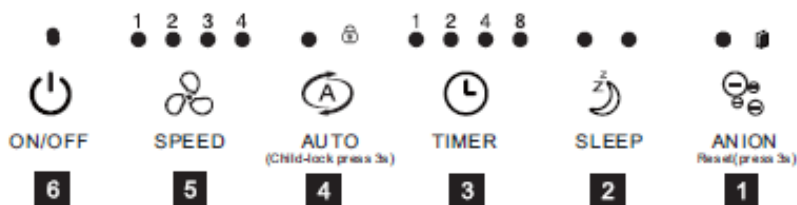
Reinstall the side covers. Align the bottom hooks with the latches, secure them, and close the covers.



TO NOTE

Record the date of first use on the nameplate label at the rear of the unit. Replace filters regularly according to usage to maintain optimal performance. It is recommended to replace the filter every 6 months of use.

INDICATOR LIGHT OF AIR QUALITY



- 1 Anion(filter replacement reset)button
- 2 SLEEP button
- 3 TIMER button
- 4 Auto speed (child-lock) button
- 5 Wind speed button
- 6 ON/OFF button
- 7 Indicator light of air quality
- 8 Digital display of PM2.5

TURNING ON THE AIR PURIFIER



After the power is connected, all indicator lights will flash briefly. Once the flashing stops, the air purifier will automatically enter AUTO mode. Press the ON/OFF button to start operation. The built-in air quality sensor will begin detecting the ambient air quality at the unit's location. After approximately 10 minutes, the current air quality will be indicated by different indicator light colors, as shown in the figure below.

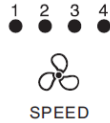
BLUE	GOOD

AUTO MODE



After powering on, the air purifier enters standby mode. Press ON/OFF to start, and it will enter AUTO mode, adjusting fan speed based on air quality. In high humidity, condensation may affect the sensor, causing high fan speed. If this occurs, clean the sensor or switch to manual mode.

MANUAL ADJUSTMENT OF WIND SPEED



Press SPEED button, the wind speed will change as you press accordingly. Speed 1, speed 2 and so on.

SLEEP MODE



In AUTO mode, if the room is dim, the air purifier will enter SLEEP mode after 3 minutes. All indicators turn off except the power light, and fan speed/noise drop to the lowest level. When the room brightens for 3 minutes, the unit returns to its previous settings.

TIMER MODE



The TIMER button allows you to select an operating duration of 1, 2, 4, or 8 hours. Once the selected time has elapsed, the air purifier will automatically power off.

ANION MODE



Press the ANION button to turn the function on (beep and indicator light on). Press again to turn it off. When a filter replacement is due, the indicator light will illuminate. After replacing the filter, press and hold ANION for 3 seconds to reset the reminder; the wind speed light will stop flashing.

CHILDLOCK FUNCTION

While the unit is running (except in SLEEP mode), press and hold the Child-lock button for 3 seconds. A beep will sound, and the Child-lock indicator will turn on. While activated, all buttons are disabled except the Child-lock button.

Troubleshooting

FAULT	CAUSE	SOLUTION
Machine unable to work	Front panel not installed correctly	Disassemble front panel and re-install
	No power supply to unit	Ensure unit power is connected
	Main power faulty	Ensure the main power is ON and supplying the correct current output
Fan unable to work	Machine does not turn ON	Ensure the main power is turned ON
	Machine is not on a leveled surface	Ensure the machine is on a flat, level surface
	Filter packaging not removed	Ensure all packaging is removed from the unit
